Relay Race 2008

A six-person relay set in the confines of Windsor Great Park and in sight of Windsor Castle.

All legs start and finish at the same point so there are no complicated changeovers to organise. The race is designed to appeal to athletes, joggers, families and all sports minded people. Families and supporters are very welcome, ideal for a picnic. Fun Runs will also be provided for under 12's.

Each team is to comprise six runners. This may include no more than 3 senior males (aged 16 to 39). The remainder of the team may comprise juniors, ladies and veteran male runners.

Age on 28th June 2008 dictates category. Each runner may only run one leg and for only one team. Runners may run in any order, names to be declared on race day.

Approximate leg lengths are 5.25 miles for legs 1, 3 and 5, and 2.75 miles for legs 2, 4 and 6.

The first leg starts at 12 noon. Entry fee is £36 per team.
